We were so excited to reconnect with families and meet new ones last night at the Welcome Back BBQ and Meet the Teacher. One of our pillars at Meadow Ridge is to "Nurture Community". Ensuring your child is safe while at school is a priority for us. The following is important information that helps us keep your children safe:

Severe Allergies

A severe allergy is one where someone has an anaphylactic response to an allergen, which, if left untreated, might lead to sudden death. It is a shared responsibility between the school, parents and students to minimize the risk of exposure to the allergen.

It is important to note that it is parent's responsibility to notify the school of a severe allergy. We are asking parents to notify the office if your child has a severe allergy to ensure we have proper documentation and location of epi-pens and our records are up to date. If there is a severe allergy in your child's class, teachers have sent an email home notifying you to please send food that is free of that allergen, usually nuts and fish.

Transportation and Parking

We want to thank all of our parents and students for following the expectations for pick up and drop off. Thank you for using the main parking lot on the north side rather than parking in the bus zone. As we finish off the first month, please remember the following:

- **No Parking Zones:** There is **no** parking, stopping or dropping off along Chinook Arch Way as it is a main road or at the front parking loop in front of the main entrance. Chinook Arch Way is a main road and we need to keep the traffic flowing. The parking loop in front of the school is reserved for families who have children with limited mobility. It is important to keep this loop as clear as possible as we did have some near misses last year.
- **Fire Lane:** Please ensure the Fire Lane in the main parking lot is clear at all times.

Attendance & Leaving Early

It is important to know if students are leaving school in case there is an emergency. Everyone must be accounted for.

Meadow Ridge is a CLOSED CAMPUS which means students are expected to stay on the school grounds during lunch. Students may walk home for lunch if they can return within the 30 minute lunch time. They need to bring a note signed at the office at the beginning of the year and then need to sign out when leaving and sign in when returning.

In order to leave school early, parents need to pick up their child and sign them out at the office or call. Students need to then sign out.
