

What's happening in Grade 3?

READING: The students have had an opportunity to explore RAZ Kids and Get EPIC. This week it's time to get down to business! In RAZ Kids they will need to (listen), read, and do the quiz for each book they choose. I've also assigned a collection of continent books (UOI) on Get EPIC. Next week I will be introducing daily reading comprehension passages to complete in the morning, before PE.

WRITING: Last week everyone chose one journal entry for me to assess. This week we will focus on beginning/introduction sentences, using the question as a starting point. **SPELLING:** Thank you for helping your child work through the weekly spelling activities at home. This week is List B4.

MATH: Our Daily Math questions have led to a lot of in class discussions beyond our Place Value and Number of the Day practice. Please take a few minutes to review the pages sent home last

week. We highlight important "Math" words and are working on adding them to our Math Vocabulary.

UOI: Now that we know where the 4 countries of focus are, we will zoom in on the geographical regions in each (rainforest, mountains, desert, etc) and the importance each play in the culture of the country.
