

SCHOOL EVALUATIONS

Background

Evaluations will be designed to assist schools to establish and maintain appropriate instructional, program and management standards.

Procedures

1. The Superintendent is responsible for the evaluation of schools depending on need and the availability of resources.
2. The evaluation may include a review of stakeholder satisfaction, student success, staff competence, facility adequacy, program quality, support services or any other factor deemed necessary.
3. The Principal shall, within sixty (60) calendar days of the receipt of the evaluation report, provide a written action plan which effectively addresses the recommendations contained in the evaluation report. The Superintendent shall set the format for the action plans.
