Administrative work started March 16 for all the COVID-19 measures. The FSD model has been picked up and used across the province for the relaunches

Funding

- Federal government provided provinces 2B for safe school relaunch
- Foothills school div received 2.864 million dollars. Given in two payments. One received already, 1.474 million dollars.
- Using money to prioritize keeping class sizes small enough for educators to be able to handle diversity with confidence. Increase educational assistance support. And an Increase in staff for Hub at Home. 10% of population moved to H@H.

Rebecca: Added they hired 2.5 education assistants with the funding received.

Sharon:

Budgeting, Calculations for enrollment projections are down 2.6% and under the new government funding rules, our funding would be down as a result. They are advocating to the government that FSD be held harmless because of COVID-19 and want to be funded based on last year's projections.

The board is focused on budget and that we get what we need to maintain the quality of programs we have.

Continued to get lots of presentations at board meetings, Rebecca and Brad presented. The Board also has a presentation from two teachers, Ryan Lempers and Graham Campbell. They have been working on nature-based learning. Proposed to the board to complete a feasibility study for an alternative nature-based study course. If accepted, it would be housed at Percy Pegler. The project would impact all schools in FSD and available for all students. No bussing would be available.

The other presentation from Marilyn Boake, who was hired to work on grant proposals for the division. Decided to setup an arm's length Charitable foundation separates from school division, for programs that would benefit all schools in the division. The motion was passed to move forward with the application to the CRA. This will aim to attract community support for the School division.
