



OILFIELDS HIGH SCHOOL 2021/2022 GRADE 10 COURSE REGISTRATION

The purpose of this form is to help parents and students discuss, plan and choose courses at Oilfields High School.

CHOOSING COURSES (*Course Selection planning form is on the opposite side.*)

The courses chosen in Grade 10 determine the Grade 11 and Grade 12 courses completed and the Post-Secondary programs/careers to which students may apply. Select courses that will allow flexibility for your future.

Plan carefully because the timetable is created based on your class choices. Once the schedule has been built, specific changes may be difficult or impossible to make. Selection of a course does not ensure you will be able to fit it into your schedule, although every attempt will be made to accommodate you.

Registration Procedures: fill out the other side of this form by checking off the courses you wish to take.

- Courses successfully passed in grade 9 allows for students to choose ELA 10-1, Social 10-1, Science 10 and Math 10C.
- Math 10C Prep is a course for students who struggled in math 9 and want to ensure readiness for Math 10C.
- Grade 10 classes are prerequisite courses for going into grade 11.
- University bound students should register in ELA 10-1, SST 10-1, Science 10 and Math 10C.
- College bound students should register in -1 or -2 ELA and Social, Science 10, and math 10C.
- Apprenticeship students should register in -1 or -2 ELA and Social, Science 10, and Math 10C or 10-3.
- Students wanting to graduate and work and do not plan on advancing their education after graduation should register in -1 or -2 ELA and Social, Science 10 or 14, and Math 10C or 10-3.
- CALM/CTR and Physical Education 10 are mandatory for graduation.
- Rank your Wellness, CTS/Fine Arts and Second Language choices in case a requested course could not be timetabled for you. #1 is your top choice and we will do our best to give you your top choices.
- Spares are typically offered in grade 12 only.
- Ensure that you have selected enough courses for a full timetable (40 credits.)
- Complimentary (option) courses in grade 9 are NOT prerequisites for grade 10. Students can choose their interests and explore career pathways.
