### GRADE 12 COURSE REGISTRATION

This form is to help you plan and choose courses for the upcoming school year.

The purpose of this form is to help parents and students discuss, plan and choose courses at Oilfields High School.

**CHOOSING COURSES** (*Course Selection planning form is on the opposite side.*)

The courses chosen in Grade 10 determine the Grade 11 and Grade 12 courses completed and the post-secondary programs/careers students may apply. Select courses that will allow flexibility for your future.

Plan carefully because the timetable is created based on your class choices. Once the schedule has been built, specific changes may be difficult or impossible to make. Selection of a course does not ensure you will be able to fit it into your schedule, although every attempt will be made to accommodate you.

**Registration Procedures: fill out the other side of this form, checking off the courses you wish to take.**

- Grade 11 classes (20 level) are prerequisite courses for grade 12 (30 level) classes.
- CALM/CTR and Physical Education 10 are mandatory for graduation.
- University bound students should register in ELA 30-1, SST 30-1, Biology, Chemistry and/or Physics30, and Math 30-1 or 30-2. Which one depends on the program and career pathway students are choosing.
- College bound students should register in -1 or -2 ELA and Social, Biology, Chemistry and/or Physics 30, and Math 30-1 or 30-2. Which one depends on the program and career pathway students are choosing.
- Apprenticeship students should register in -1 or -2 ELA and Social, Science at the 30 level unless you have Science 24 then you have met grad requirements, and math 30-1, 30-2 or 30-3.
- Students wanting to graduate and work and do not plan on advancing their education after graduation should register in -1 or -2 ELA and Social, any 30 level Science unless you have Science 24 then you have met grad requirements. Math 30-1, 30-2 or 30-3. Math at the 20 level does meet grad requirements.
- Rank your Wellness, CTS/Fine Arts and Second Language choices in case a requested course could not be timetabled for you. #1 is your top choice and we will do our best to give you your top choices.
- Spares are typically offered in grade 12 only.
- Ensure that you have selected enough courses\* for graduation (30 credits) and the correct courses for Post-Secondary pursuits. (\*off campus does not count until you are registered in the program through Mz. Isberg.)

If you are unsure about graduation or Post-Secondary requirements, take the time to speak to Mz. Isberg and your teachers. Information regarding Post-Secondary requirements can be researched through students' myBlueprint account.
