

STUDENT PLACEMENT – OUT OF DIVISION PROGRAMS

Background

The Division is committed to the provision of high quality education programming for each of its students within Division schools and programs. The following procedures stipulate conditions wherein Division students may gain access to programs provided by other school authorities.

The Superintendent or designate is responsible for the administration of this administrative procedure.

Procedures

1. Placement by Parental Choice
 - 1.1 Provincial legislation enables a parent to enroll a student in any school of any Board if that Board agrees there are sufficient resources and facilities.
 - 1.2 Such placements are at no cost to the Division except under conditions specified in these procedures. Transportation will not be provided.

2. Division Directed Special Education Placements
 - 2.1 While the Division strives to provide programming to meet the learning needs of each student, the Superintendent or designate may direct a student to attend a school of another school authority (such as a special education private school).
 - 2.2 In such cases, the Division may enter into an agreement to provide additional funding to cover the net cost of the student's school program under the provisions of the School Act and Alberta Education regulations.
