

COURSE CHALLENGE

Background

A course challenge process shall be available to senior high school students who feel they have already acquired the expected knowledge, skills and attitudes for a senior high school course, as specified in the Program of Studies, and are ready to demonstrate that achievement through a formal assessment process.

The Superintendent or designate is responsible for the administration of this administrative procedure.

Procedures

1. The process and procedures for course challenge shall comply with Alberta Education regulations as detailed in the current Guide to Education.
2. Each high school Principal shall develop course challenge procedures and appropriate course challenge assessment processes.
3. Each high school Principal shall establish procedures to communicate to parents and students the availability of and procedures for, course challenges.
