

INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE AND RENEWAL

Background

The Division believes:

- That all school buildings are to be safe for school and community use;
- That all facilities are to be maintained on a continuing basis;
- That the life of school facilities can be extended through appropriate use of Alberta Education's Infrastructure Maintenance and Renewal Program (IMR).

Procedures

1. The Assistant Superintendent, Corporate Services is responsible for the overall administration of the Infrastructure Maintenance and Renewal Program (IMR).
2. The Division will use the Infrastructure Maintenance and Renewal Program (IMR) to achieve these ends:
 - 2.1 To ensure utilized buildings are structurally sound and safe.
 - 2.2 To replace selected major components of buildings that have failed.
 - 2.3 To ensure buildings function to meet intended educational needs.
 - 2.4 To ensure that the funds are allocated on a planned, and prioritized basis.
