In our Unit of Inquiry this week, we will be focusing our time on researching Arctic Foxes and Narwhals. We will look at their appearance and physical adaptations to survive in the Arctic. We will inquire into their diet, enemies, and life cycle.

In Numeracy, we will continue practicing addition to 20 and subtraction from 20. We will focus on math families (3+9= 12, 9+3=12, 12-9= 3, 12-3= 9).
