What's Happening in Grade 2?

Last week the students had a wonderful time exploring different number patterns. The students have started to to observe and find patterns everywhere! They are finding patterns in the traditional clothing people wear, such as during Ukrainian festivals in the community of Saskatoon! The students also started creating posters about different patterns and systems that can be found in nature, such as beehives, dragonfly wings, ripples in water, the designs on sea shells and on animal's bodies.
