- 2-4 glue sticks (if you pick small ones, more would be needed, but they might be ideal space-savers) **Bring 1 to start**

To have on hand at home so it can be brought in when needed:

- 1 ruler 30 cm (plastic, NO metal please!)
- 1-2 twin pocket folders (plastic or paper)
- 1 small container of playdough 112g
- 1 plastic/vinyl placemat (choose one that can be folded or rolled)
- 1 deck of cards (in a plastic ziploc bag)
- 1 a collection of bingo chips or some other counter (in a small ziploc bag)
- 1 small package of white paper
- 1 small package of graph paper (small squares, please!)

One art box/bag/tote with the following inside: Keep at home to start...

- 1 package Crayola markers OR Mr. Sketch markers (not both!!)
- 1 small watercolour paint box [something like this](#)
- 1 2-3 cm flat paint brush (for doing washes), [such as can be found in this assorted package](#)
- 1 smaller all-purpose paint brush
- 1 small container for water (not more than 250mL) a repurposed plastic container from recycling is perfect
- 1 bottle of white school glue
Optional: a small amount of scrapbook paper scraps and other art supplies for visual journal

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
